Pre Solo Training - AOPA

The pre-solo knowledge test checks that you know basic rules and procedures prior to flying solo. For many students, working on this test is their first real introduction to aviation regulations. The pre-solo knowledge test I use covers more than the minimum required by 61.87(b). (It's based upon a recommended test from AOPA). The test is open book, but students should know their airplanes basic speeds by memory.

14 CFR § 61.87 - Solo requirements for student pilots ...

Advisory Circular 61-101, Pre-solo Written Test, indicates that you also should have adequate knowledge to operate safely during solo flight in your local training environment. If the surrounding area includes controlled airspace, such as Class B, C, D, or E airspace, you may be asked to answer appropriate questions on operations in those areas.
